Borunov Dmitriy Aleksandrovich,
born on August 11, 1961, Russian, architect,
Director General of “DABOR” LLC

In 1978 – 1983 – studied at Penza Construction-Engineering Institute with a specialization in architecture.

In 1983 – defense of the diploma project on the topic: “Restoration of Saint Trinity Skanov Monastery – a pearl of Penza architecture of 18-th century”.

In 1983 – Head Architectural and Planning Department of Penza, project execution of CNIIEP (Central Research Institute of Engineering Design of inhabited and public facilities) of town planning of Moscow on reconstruction of the historic center of Penza City.

Simultaneously (with some intervals, till 1995) - he worked as a lecturer of Penza Construction-Engineering Institute, lecturing on town planning history, architectural design.

In 1980 – 1989, as agreed with Penza Regional Executive Board, by the order of Scientific Research Institute of the Ministry for Culture of RSFSR he prepared materials of the Cope of historical and cultural monuments of the Penza Region. He actively participated in this work and wrote more than 200 articles.

In 1987 – he was a head of the production group on protection of historical and cultural monuments of the Penza Region.

Since 1989, on blessing of the archbishop Serafim (Tikhonov), he worked in Penza diocese as a diocesan architect, he implemented project and production works on restoration, reconstruction and construction of religious buildings of the Penza diocese:

design of the baptistery temple of Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary at Uspensky Cathedral of Penza, the building of diocesan authority. Direct participation in rebuilding projects on Kerensky Tikhvinsky and Trinity Skanov monasteries, on restoration of Protection of the Blessed Virgin Temple and other temples of the Region from ruins.

Since 1994 – he was a union member of architects of Russia.

In 1995 he received a nominal license for creation and management of a creative architectural workshop (enterprise) with the right of all types of works performance, connected with restoration, reconstruction, design and arrangement of Orthodox churches.

In 1996, he founded “DABOR” LLC (Moscow) for the purpose of practical activity in the field of temple-building.

At that time, by D.A. Borunov’s projects there were built:

Temple of St. Nikolay Merlikiyskiy, wonders-worker (Akhuny settlement), the temple complex in honor of a great martyr of Demetrius of Thessaloniki in the village of Lesnoy Vyas of the Luninsky Region,

the temple of the Nativity in Zemetchino settlement of Penza Region,

St. Nikolsky Temple in Semiley village of the Republic of Mordovia, and also,

the temple of the Lord's Epiphany in Naryan-Mar of the Nenets Autonomous Area,

Temple complexes in the Republic Lithuania – in honor of the Iverian icon of God's Mother in Palanga and Pokrovo-Nikolsky in Klaipeda,

Temple of the Nativity in Nemchinovka settlement of the Moscow Region and others.

From 1995 to 2004 - management of works on restoration of Nikolo-Perervinsky Monastery of Moscow where historical reconstruction of iconostases of Nikolsky and Iversky cathedrals were performed and works on facades and fencing restoration were performed.

In 2002-2003 by the order of the Department of External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchy, he arranged the house temple of St. Princess Olga, Equal-to-the-Apostles in the Pilgrim Center of "Universitetskaya" hotel, an iconostasis and icon cases in the Trinity Church of Brussels.

In 2008, he made measurement charts of the metochion of Saint Nikolay, the wonder-worker, in Bari (Italy) for his transfer under supervision of ROC (Russian Orthodox Church) of the Moscow Patriarchate and preparation to carry out design and restoration works.

During the period from 2003 to 2009, about 30 iconostases in Orthodox churches of Russia and abroad were made and mounted by the workshop.

In 2009, the iconostasis for the temple of Saints Konstantin and Elena, Equal-to-the-Apostles, was made in Istanbul and the complex of works on the Assumption Date Temple was performed in Beijing (People's Republic of China) at Embassies of the Russian Federation.

The workshop made iconostasis, domes, door units and roofing works on the temple in honor of the icon of the Mother of God "Sovereign" in the residence of Gorki-9 of the President of the Russian Federation - D. A. Medvedev. In 2010, D. A. Borunov was awarded by a nominal gift of the President for this work.

At present time, by the project of a workshop, the pilgrim hotel at St. John the Evangelist monastery is constructed in Saransk (Mordovia), organizational and design works are carried out for the house temple in GTRK (State Television and Radio Broadcasting Company) "Ostankino", design of the Assumption Day temple complex in Matveevsky is carried out and construction of the temple of the reverend Andrei Rublev on Michurinsk avenue (Moscow) is conducted.

D.A. Borunov is a participant of the Church Council of the Russian Orthodox Church of the year of 1990 from laymen of the Penza diocese.

Since 2006, he has been a Chairman of a Parish Council of Voznesensky temple of Penza.

He was awarded a medal of the Russian Orthodox Church of the Reverend Seraphim Sarovskiy of the 3-rd degree, bishopric blessed diplomas of several dioceses of the Moscow Patriarchate of Russian Orthodox Church, diplomas and diplomas of the Union of architects of Russia.
